



Asiimananda Divas

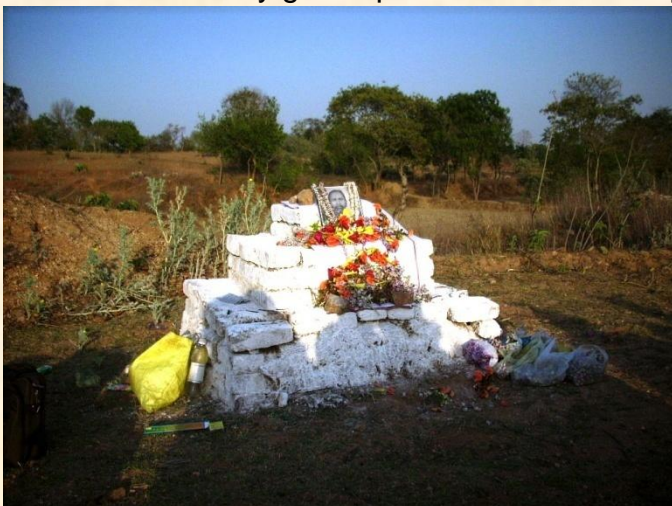
On 2nd April, 2013 Asiimananda Divas was observed at Bakul Vitan, Pundag, Anandanagar by conducting a public meeting.

In the year 1990, on this day Dada Asiimananda with 4 other margii brothers were killed brutally by the goons of the then ruling Communist Party at Chatka village when he was coming back from Dimdiha Farm unit after inspection. Every year this day we memorize his valuable contribution for Anandanagar. He was specialist in Agricultural science. Ashokji from Jhalda gave a very inspirational speech. Everybody did homage to Asimanandaji.



Radhu Soren Smriti Divas

On 5th April, 1994 Sri Radhu Soren was killed by the then Communist Party in an open field at Pogro village. He was a progressive minded social worker of tribal community. He used to preach Ananda Marga philosophy, used to protest against superstition, dogma, exploitation of local political leaders. This day is being observed by open protest meeting, kiirtana, Narayan seva (mass feeding). Also well wishers visited the field where he was brutally murdered. Many Margi brothers voluntarily gave speech from their deep heart
