- 8) Navacakra Guhá, a 5,500 year- old man-made cave.
- 9) Dinosaur fossil.
- 10) The oldest Jaena temple, 2300 years old, at Deolghata
- 11) Kapil Hill, the birthplace of the earliest philosopher, Maharsi Kapila and Kapila Guhá (cave) where he wrote his book on the Sánkhya Philosophy.
- 12) The confluence of the Dakśińá and the Uttará and the tantra centre called the 'Candidasa Cárańá'
- 13) The confluence of the Dakśińá and the Kunti, and the centre of Western Rárha hallowed by the footfall of Krśńa and Sadáshiva.
- 14) The Paská cave and tantra centre in the central region of Ánandanagar, hallowed by the footfall of Sadáshiva.
- 15) Many other tantric centres where for ages spiritual seekers practised and attained the realization of the Supreme Being.
- 16) Healthy, clean and pure climate.
- 17) Shriishrii Ánandamuurti called the water of Ánandanagar "tiirtha udakam" (holy water). He drank this water throughout the last five years of his life. This water is rich in various minerals and very good for health.
- 18) Multifaceted projects for education, service and development by Ánandamárga.
