Five-Day Sháradiá Utsava or Autum Festival

As per Ananda Marga Caryacarta Part 1, Five-day Festival of Sháradotsava should be celebrated from the sixth day to the tenth day of the bright fortnight of Áshvina as follows:

- 1. The first day: the Shárad Śaśthii is the Children's Day
- 2. The second day: the Shárad Saptamii is the Public Day
- 3. The third Day: the Shárad Astamii is the Fine Arts Day
- 4. The fourth day: the Shárad Navamii is the Music Day
- 5. The fifth day: the Sharad Dashamii is the Vijayotsava

Accordingly in Ananda Nagar all these five days festival of Sháradotsava was celebrated from 11th to 15th October.

11th October the Shárad Śaśthii: Six hours 'Bábá Nám Kevalam' Akhanda Kiirtan was organized in Darda village. On this occasion, Kiirtan procession, collective lishvar Pranidhan, Svadhay were done. Acarya Vishvamitrananda Avadhuta explained the importance of Sharad Utsav. Programme ends with Narayan Seva and collective meal.





12th October the Shárad Saptamii: Ananda Marga Girls High School distributed new clothes to fifty five children from Damrughutu, Khatanga and Pagro villages of Ananda Nagar and Girls Volunteers of Uma Nivas distributed new clothes to thirty eight children of Banshgarh village of Ananda Nagar and they also distributed Notebooks, pencils and biscuits distributed to 100 children of Ekduara village.





13th October the Shárad Aśtamii: Vijay Mahato organized twelve hours akhanda Nám samkiirtan "Bábá Nám Kevalam" in Kamukhap village of Jaipur police station on the occasion of Shárad Aśtamii. Here women's football competition, medical camp, Narayan Seva, distribution of clothes, cultural program in the evening was organized. At the end of the kiirtan, Acarya Devatmananda Avadhuta explained the significance of the collective lishvar Pranidhan, Svadhya and Sharadiya utsav.









14th October Shárad Navamii: On this occasion there was collective lishvar Pranidhan, musical program and a collective meal in the evening at the Upper Hostel.

Acarya Muktananda Avadhuta spoke on the significance of Vijaya dashami. At the end of the kiirtan, a cultural program based on Prabhat Samgiita was organized.





Community Projects: Building Anandanagar initiative

In order to make economically backward women financially self-sufficient in Ananda Nagar, the Ananda Marga Women's Welfare Department has taken up a master plan for training, producing and marketing of various edible products through cottage industries.

Initially, a special training was carried out by a renowned Mumbai trainer with the initiative and supervision of Mrs. Ashwini Sandu, General Bhukti Pradhan, Mumbai, for the preparation, processing and preservation of various pure Sattvik (sentient) food items scientifically. Two delegates Avadhutika Ananda Sevabrata Acarya and Avadhutika Ananda Smritisudha Acarya from Ananda Nagar undergone in the special training from 8 to 15 October. Total 68 special food recipes of different states were prepared for training. Below are some samples from that.





The second industry of the project is Jari industry/Zardusi industry. [Zardozi comes from two Persian words: zar or zarin meaning 'gold', and dozi meaning 'sewing'. Initially, the embroide

meaning 'gold', and dozi meaning 'sewing'. Initially, the embroidery was done with pure silver wires and real gold leaves. However, today, craftsmen make use of a combination of copper wire, with a golden or silver polish, and silk thread.]

An experienced instructor of the industry discussed with the women of Damrughutu and Chitmu village about the needs and possibilities of this industry in detail and also about training and marketing including showing some samples of the work on 17 and 18 October '21.
