Trials for Selection of Women Footballer

3rd and 4th December: Trials for Selection of Women Footballers from Ananda Nagar Diocese were held which was organized by Ananda Nagar Sports Academy. Srimati Alpana Sheel (International Woman Footballer) and Srimati Suparna Bag, all from Kolkata, conducted the selection where more than 100 woman footballers participated. 11 players were selected in the pre-trial matches held at Ananda Nagar. The final selection was done at and around Kolkata from the trial matches started from 15th December. Finally four players were selected by two teams "Maitri Samgha" and "Rainbow" and will be playing in the Senior Division Football League at Kolkata which is scheduled to be started from 5th January, 2022.

The project will be beneficial to Umànivàs Girls Children's Home, Rarh Girls Hostel, Women's Guest House and newly formed Women's College.
