Dada Asiimananda Memorial Day

2nd April: Ananda Marga has been working tirelessly for the education, development and welfare of the people since the inception of Anandanagar in 1963. This service work could not be tolerated by some people of a non-ideal, selfish, evil nature with some distorted mentality. They are constantly obstructing, killing, looting, spreading false propaganda, misleading the simple-minded innocent people and leading them astray. They have slowed down the pace of human development and are delaying the progress of the common man by one hundred years.

On April 2, 1990 they attacked Acarya Asiimananda Avadhuta, an renowned agricultural scientist, Arjun Singh and Dara Singh of the local Kosangi village, Radhu Garain of Chitmu village and Deenbandhu Singh from Uttar Pradesh in the village of Chatka in Anandanagar. In broad daylight, they were brutally hacked to death by communist goons backed by the then ruling party. Since then, April 2 has been celebrated as Asiimananda Memorial Day every year. On this occasion, a three-hour Akhanda "Baba Nam Kevalam" kiirtan and collective lishvar Pranidhan is performed at Dimdiha Ananda Marga Jagriti Bhavan near Chatka. In addition, tributes were paid to the martyrs, reminiscence, clothing and financial assistance were provided to the families of Arjun Singh and Dara Singh and Narayan seva was organized.

3rd March: Laying of foundation stone of new house of Shri Subhash Mahato, resident of Singhaghara village was done according to the Ananda Marga Caryacarya rules with bhajan, kiirtan, collective lishvar Pranidhan and 3taking oath together.

Three hours Akhanda "Baba Nam Kevalam" Kiirtan and Narayan Seva was performed at Shri Madhu Singhghatwal's residence in Katiya village.



Radhu Soren Memorial Day

5th April: Under an unmistakable leadership of Shri Shri Anandamurtiji, a group of selfless volunteers determined to implement Ananda Marga's universal and comprehensive ideology. They are against some vested interests and reactionaries. That is why the sinners and the enemies of humanity continue to oppress the Ananda Marga, the workers and the followers of the Ananda Marga. An example of such a follower is Shri Radhu Soren, a resident of Damrughutu village in Ananda Nagar. He was inspiring the so-called Santal society through moral, ideological and science based education to get rid of some illogical superstitions. But on April 5, 1995, on his way back to his village from Kotshila, he was hacked to death in broad daylight by the enemies of humanity. Since then, the villagers of Damrughutu have been observing this day as "Shri Radhu Soren Memorial Day".

On this occasion, they paid homage at " Radhu Smriti Bhavan" by doing Akhanda nam samkirtan for three hours and collective lishvar Pranidhan. They also organized tributes, reminiscences and Narayan seva.



Encouraging Intelligent Students

10th April: In order to help the intelligent students of the adjoining villages of Anandanagar to study and encouraging them financially, Ananda Marga Gurukul organized a talent search program through "Shambhu Narayan Roy Memorial fifth class merit search test and scholarship examination" in the Ananda Marga High School today. 250 students

participated. The first twenty students who passed the examination are given one-time scholarships of **Rs. 2000** and certificates.

10th to 11th April: 24-hour Akhanda nam samkiirtan of "Baba Nam Kevalam" was conducted in Ghaghara village. On the evening of April 10, many people from the village came to listen to the kiirtan. Narayan Seva was organized on 11th April.

Inauguration of Second Campus of Farm Dept

14th April: The second campus of Ananda Marg Farm Department was inaugurated at Bansgarh area under Kotshila Police Station. On this occasion, three hours of Akhanda kiirtan and Narayan seva were organized. The project is built on fifty acres of land. The entire land is walled. Maltese lemons have been cultivated on three acres of land here. Apple plants have been planted experimentally. This season the apple trees have flowers and fruits also have come now. Fruit trees like Dragon, Litchi, Milkfruit, Apricot, Rambutan etc. have also been planted experimentally.

For this purpose, training, production and marketing of cottage industries like Zari-Zardushi, Artificial flower Garland, Jam-Jelly, Pickle, Pulses chunk etc. has been arranged and being continued. In some cases, the products are sold to wholesalers. We want direct wholesale and retail sales also so that producers can get real value for their labour. The journey of Zari-Zardushi industry has started with the women of Damrugutu and Chitmu villages.

Thes the first commercial production of lehenga, blouse and orna by the women of Damrugutu and Chitmu villages after five months of relentless practice (training) of Jari / Jardushi cottage industry are shown below. Now the work of sari is going on.
