Prabhat Samgiita Day Celebrated

14th Sept: The "Prabhat Samgiita Day" was observed at Ananda Marga High School, by practicing Prabhat Samgiita and discussion on significance and importance of Prabhat Samgiita.

Shrii Prabhat Ranjan Sarkar who wrote 5018 songs in eight languages of Bengali, Sanskrit, English, Hindi, Urdu, Angika, Maithili, Magahi and tuned all of them. These songs include Baul, Kiirtan, Bhatiali, Jhumur, Toppa, Thungri, Qawali, Ghazal etc.

Prabhat Samgiita started with "Bandhu Hey Niye Calo" on 14th September 1982 in the then Deoghar city of Bihar State and now in Jharkhand state and ended with the last song on 20th October 1990 at Kolkata with "Ámrá Gore Nebo Gurukul". These songs have enriched the repertoire of more than five thousand Prabhat Samgiita, where many extinct and foreign tunes have been added. Shrii Prabhat Ranjan Sarkar made full use of every moment of time with unimaginable skill. Every day HE gave enlightening discourses on various mysterious subjects like Panchanan (five faces) Shiva, all of which were published in books. Above all was to keep a thorough account of every moment of his world-wide organization and its hundreds of self-sacrificing workers and countless projects.

In this boundless busyness, without neglecting the favorable natural environment, sometimes on the way during a journey, sometimes late at night, sometimes in the early morning, sometimes at dusk, or at midday, certain groups of monks are called to write down songs and pick up the tune.

Yes, that's right, because he didn't write himself; he created each piece of music with extraordinary speed by multiplying the qualities, fixing the melody and putting the right words on it, like the Vedic sages creating verses. In this way, in about eight years, he has created a huge collection of more than five thousand Prabhat Samgiitas.
