Water conservation Project in Umanivas

Ananda Nagar, Umanivas girls' home, women's college and Rarh hostel designated for service project of women's department are facing severe water shortage especially during summer. Gurudev's instructions are to conserve rainwater and make the natural environment more conducive to rainfall rather than using underground water.

In order to solve this problem, under the initiative of family Acarya Kishan Sood Dada, the senior magii of Ananda Marga Mission and under the supervision of Bangalore resident Shri Nikhil Udupa, who is an expert in natural environment creation and water conservation, a science-based topography and landscape survey were prepared on 22 acres of land around the Umanivas Unit and the project work is almost completed with a greater capacity.

Through this project it is expected:

- 1) The land of 22 acres can be recharged and the wells of Umanivas complex will have sufficient water throughout the year.
- 2) The nearby village ponds will be filled with water and will help to increase the soil moisture.
- 3) Village people can get financial benefit by farming fish in the pond.
- 4) If soil moisture is increased, plants and trees will grow easily.
- 5) Other long-term benefits will be observed over time.

I am eternally grateful and respectful to all those who have contributed in thought, money and labor to this project.

All kinds of fruits and other trees can be grown easily in the soil of Ananda Nagar with a little effort. And one or the other fruit will be available throughout the year. In summer, jaggery from the juice of palm trees, in winter from date palm juice and jaggery from the same, both trees grow in Ananda Nagar.

Bhairavi Dungri (Banshgarh) farm house date palm trees are being milled for juce and jaggery also organic cauliflower is grown for sale.





Generally these ponds remain dry or very less water or muddy in the winter but this year presently it is almost filled
